The Commission is of the opinion that Regulation 70.01, promulgated by General Order No. 5, should be amended by deleting the last sentence relating to the operation of air-conditioned buses, and that Regulation 70.05 should be amended by changing the "manufacturer's rated seating capacity" to "actual seating capacity".

The purpose of these changes is to afford the bus-traveling public an adequate standard of service.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the last sentence of Regulation 70.01, "This ratio may be increased to 150% during any 30 minute period, provided all buses in the 30 minute period are air-conditioned" be, and it is hereby, deleted.
2. That Regulation 70.05 be amended as follows:
"70.05. The seating capacity of all buses shall be the actual seating capacity."
3. That this Order become effective thirty (30) days from the date of issuance hereof.
