
Under Article XII, Section 10(a) of the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Regulation Compact, this Commission may require periodic reports from any carrier under its jurisdiction.

The Commission is of the opinion that requiring an annual report from its certificated carriers is an effective means of keeping itself and the public informed regarding the sightseeing industry which serves the Washington Metropolitan District.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the following Regulation be, and it is hereby, prescribed and adopted, effective this date:

67-03. Every carrier holding a certificate of public convenience and necessity issued by the Commission shall file with the Commission, on or before the 31st day of March of each year, an annual report, in such form as the Commission shall prescribe, setting forth financial, statistical, and general information pertaining to its sightseeing operations.
