On August 22, 1963, the Commission issued Order No. 299, setting forth proposed Rules and Regulations governing divestiture of property by carriers.

The Commission is of the opinion that the Rules and Regulations as set forth below should be adopted:

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the following Rules and Regulations be, and they are hereby, adopted effective thirty (30) days after the issuance of this order.


68. Real Property, Removal from Service or Divestiture of:

68-01. It shall be unlawful, without the prior approval of the Commission, for any carrier engaged in regular route operations to remove from service, convert to other use, or abandon any real property used and useful in the performance of those services to the public such as are subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission.

68-02. It shall be unlawful, without the prior approval of the Commission, for any carrier engaged in regular route operations to divest itself of any real property used and useful in the performance of those services to the public such as are subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission, or of control over any such real property, whether that control be exercised via lease, option to buy, stock ownership, or otherwise.

68-03. The Commission shall not withhold approval if it finds that such action is not contrary to the public interest.
