By Order No. 500, issued June 30, 1965, the Commission published proposed regulations concerning the playing of radios on buses in the Metropolitan Area. The order provided for comments on the proposals by interested persons. Notice of the proposed regulation was published in a newspaper of general circulation within the Metropolitan district.

A substantial number of letters have been received lauding the proposed regulations and urging the adoption thereof. No one has opposed the proposed regulations.

The Commission finds that the proposed regulations are in the public interest, and should be promulgated and adopted.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the Appendix, General Order No. 8, be, and it is hereby, amended, by the promulgation and adoption of the following:

Regulation 114. PASSENGERS.

114-01. Passenger-Operated Radios.


A passenger shall not operate and make audible sounds with any radio while being transported on any bus in regular route service.

114-02. Use of Earphones.

A passenger may operate a radio with the proper use of earphones.

2. That this order become effective September 7, 1965.
