Request for Vehicle Marking Waiver Letter

Commission Regulation No. 61 generally requires that a carrier's legal name (or approved trade name) and WMATC number be displayed on the passenger and driver's side of each revenue vehicle. However, there are exceptions to this rule.

Limousines and luxury sedans seating nine persons or less, including the driver, do not need to display a name or WMATC number. Limousines and luxury sedans seating 15 persons or less, including the driver, do not need to display a name but must still display a WMATC number. The term "luxury sedans and limousines" includes sport utility vehicles, but not vans.

If no markings are on your vehicle, WMATC inspectors or other law enforcement personnel may ask for documentation showing your vehicle is operated under WMATC authority. Use this form to request a waiver letter from WMATC. Keep the letter in your vehicle along with a copy of your WMATC certificate of authority and present to law enforcement personnel when requested.
